What we're looking for

We're looking for a reliable and conscientious person to work with us on an ad-hoc basis, providing cover and support across multiple projects between July and September. There may be the potential to extend the role.

Supporting and delivering for multiple projects, you will be representing Tamar Grow Local across the Tamar Valley and Plymouth too. This is a customer-facing role and a physical one, including heavy lifting and carrying veg bags up flights of stairs!

As hours will vary, this role would be best suited to someone with a flexible schedule.

About the role:

- The role will include delivering orders and veg bags primarily across Plymouth, and potentially packing veg bags at our offices in Kelly Bray, near Callington.
- Work will primarily be on Wednesdays and Fridays.
- Hours will vary, with some early starts and evening finishes. (We will aim to provide as much notice as possible.)
- This is a physical role with heavy lifting of up to 25kg.
- You will be driving one of Tamar Grow Local's vans.



- You will support the team in maintaining the condition, cleanliness and tidiness of our vans and our premises, and completing appropriate records.
- You will monitor fuel levels and re-fuel our vans using company fuel cards when required.
- The role will be available on a PAYE or self-employed basis.
- The rate of pay is £13.45 per hour.

The Person

In an ideal world you'll be passionate about local, fresh and seasonal produce. You'll be enthused by projects that combine good economic sense with humanitarian benefits and you will relish applying systematic order but be able to cope with uncertainty.

You will:

- Be a confident and courteous driver, equally happy navigating Plymouth during rush hour as delivering down narrow country lanes.
- Be punctual and able to manage your time independently, replanning routes on the go as needed to make sure time critical deliveries are made.
- Be able to safely lift up to 25kg, and to get in and out of the van regularly to do deliveries.
- Have a keen eye for accuracy and detail, and take an organised, systematic approach to your work but have the capacity to be flexible.
- Have a clean and tidy appearance, a cheery disposition and enjoy providing excellent customer service.
- Have a passion for local, seasonal food and be happy to promote Tamar Grow Local.
- Have a willingness to "muck in" with other TGL priorities should the need arise.
- Have a desire to support the TGL team to succeed in the various linked projects.

You must:

- Have a full, clean UK driving license, with no points or convictions.
- Have had no claims within the past 3 years.
- Be able to use Google Maps or similar on your own device.
- For insurance purposes, you will need to be over 30 years old.
- Be able to get yourself to and from Kelly Bray to collect the van (paid work starts at our Kelly Bray Hub).

Please note that Tamar Grow Local has a strict no-smoking and / or vaping policy for any worker whilst undertaking Tamar Grow Local duties at any time.
